Brylov Denis is associate professor at the Department of Theology and Religious Studies, National Pedagogical Dragomanov University (Kyiv, Ukraine), achieved PhD degree in Religious Studies at Taras Shevchenko University (Kyiv). His main academic interests are Islam and Islamic education in Ukraine, political activism in Sufism and transnational Sufi movements, religious factor in conflicts, religion and nationalism. Denis Brylov is a member of Editorial Board of the journal “Essays on Religious Studies”. He has close to 50 published researches in Russian, Ukrainian, Danish, Polish, German and English. He is the editor of collected volume “Islam in Multi-cultural World” (2016) and co-editor of collected volume “Sufism and the Muslim Spiritual Tradition: Texts, Institutions, Ideas and Interpretations” (2015).
