

Curriculum Vitae – Nadire Mustafi

Nadire Mustafi is a diploma assistant and doctoral student at the *Swiss Centre for Islam and Society at the University of Fribourg* in Switzerland. She is a lecturer at the University of Innsbruck and will soon also be lecturing at the St.Gallen University of Teacher Education. In 2015 she was a Visiting Scholar of the Centre of Islamic Studies at the University of Cambridge and deepened her knowledge in the institutionalization of Islam in Great Britain.

Her research focuses on migration and integration research, Islamic religious education, democracy education and Islam and interreligious learning.

In her master thesis she worked on Imams as key figures in the process of integration and studied Islam and Migration in Europe (AE) at the postgraduate Danube University.

In addition to her research activities she worked as a teacher of Islamic religion in the general secondary schools in Vienna and lectured at the *Muslim Teachers Training College* in Vienna.

Currently she is doing research on Islam as a subject of teaching in Swiss mosques (with a focus on young target groups) as a focus of her dissertation.
